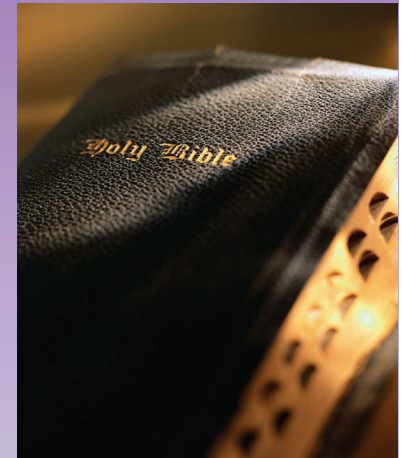

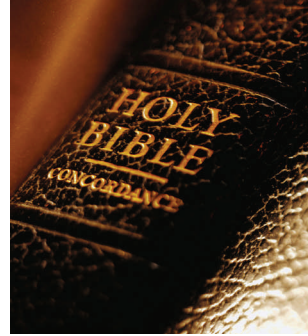

If you would like the answers to these and other Bible questions, you may want to participate in our Bible Academy. It is a program of disciplined study that requires students to read, think, and wrestle with the difficult biblical issues of our postmodern culture.



The MCC Bible Academy is offering two classes, beginning September 13, 2009; BAGB 100- "Introduction to the Bible" and BATH 100- "Introduction to the Theology of the New Testament Church." You can choose to attend classes on either Sunday morning (both classes offered) or Monday evening (BAGB) or Tuesday evening (BATH). BATH 100 runs 12 weeks. BAGB 100 runs 14 weeks. Classes will last 75 minutes each.

MCC Bible Academy course offerings are included in this brochure. Each course is a unit unto itself with no pre-requisite classes required. Courses will be offered in the sequence listed, and while it is not necessary, it is advisable to take each course in the order it is offered.
